## CONTRACTOR-GENERAL NOW RECEIVES INSTRUMENTS OF APPOINTMENT FOR FIVE MORE NCC MEMBERS

Contractor-General, Greg Christie, has announced that he has this afternoon received from Kings House the physical instruments of appointment of five (5) newly appointed members of the National Contracts Commission (NCC). The five (5) new appointees are the NCC members who have been designated by the Cabinet.

They are Mr. Robert Martin, Mrs. Jean Fairclough, Mr. Milton Hodelin, Mr. Karl Martin and Mr. Donald Moore. Mr. Robert Martin and Mr. Karl Martin have previously served on the NCC.

According to a statement which was issued this evening by the Office of the Contractor-General (OCG), the five instruments of appointment, which are dated today, June 13, were executed by the Deputy Governor General, the Very Reverend Canon the Hon. Weeville Gordon.



This now brings to six, the members of the new panel of the eight-member NCC who

have so far been appointed. Ms. Shirley Tyndall was already appointed as the Chair of

the NCC, effective May 17.

Two more persons are still to be appointed in order to complete the eight member

National Contracts Commission. One member is to be appointed from a panel of five

persons nominated by the Construction Industry Council and the other from a panel of

five nominated by the Professional Societies Association of Jamaica.

Contractor-General, Greg Christie, will present the instruments of appointment to the

new NCC members, on behalf of the Governor General.
